Above program fees include mandatory accident insurance (\$7), which remains in effect for all 2010 City-Sponsored athletic activities. If a participant paid for insurance this spring they DO NOT have to for it in the fall.

A birth certificate or a copy of the birth certificate will be required at the time of registration. If the child played for a city-sponsored team in 2009, the birth certificate will not be required.

Late Fee (Waiting List).....\$5.00

Any child not registered by August 27, 2010 will be placed on a waiting list. This *does not* guarantee your child will be placed on a team; however, once teams are formed, there *may* be space available for more players. If space is available, children on the waiting list will be called in the order their names were received at registration. The late fee will be charged, in addition to the regular program fee, on any registration received after the deadline.

RECREATION SOCCER

Age Groups / Cut-off Date (age of child on or before Aug. 31, 2010)

KICKERS - Age 5 and 6 UNDER 12 - Age 10 and 11
 UNDER 8 - Age 6 and 7 UNDER 14 - Age 12 and 13
 UNDER 10 - Age 8 and 9

*Kickers - All 6 year-olds have the option of playing in Kickers (an instructional league) or Under 8. Kickers practice and play on Saturday mornings. Kickers games will begin Saturday, September 25, 2010 - Coaches will call all players to let them know exact times and locations.

Practices - Teams may begin Tuesday, September 7, 2010

Not all practices will begin Tuesday, September 7 - Coaches will be calling all of the players to let them know when practices begin. Exact dates and times will be set by the coach. Expect to practice twice weekly until the season starts.

Jamboree - Saturday, October 2, 2010 - Manchester Meadows

Games - regular season games will begin the week following the jamboree.

Trophies/Awards - Trophies/awards are not provided by the youth soccer program. Any trophies or end of season celebrations may be handled individually by teams, but are *not* required.



COMPETITIVE SOCCER

Age Groups / Cut off date (age of child on or before July 31, 2010)

Under 12 - Age 10 and 11
 Under 16 - Age 12, 13, 14, 15

*Teams will be selected by means of a draft conducted by the youth soccer league coordinator, competitive league coaches, and RHPRT staff. There will be skills evaluation/tryouts for new players and all players moving up in age group. Any child not wanting to participate in the competitive league after skills evaluation/tryouts will be eligible to play in the recreational league.

Skills Evaluation - **Saturday, August 28, 2010** Manchester Meadows-Field #1

Under 12 - 9:00 AM
 Under 16 - 10:30 AM

Practice and Game Dates - Players will be contacted by a coach to begin practice. All new players and those wanting to move to a new age group must attend skills evaluation and go through the draft before beginning practice.

EACH PARTICIPANT IN THE COMPETITIVE LEAGUE PROGRAM MUST HAVE AT LEAST 1 PARENT/GUARDIAN ATTEND A PARENTS MEETING.

TEAM FORMATION / BOUNDARY REQUIREMENTS

All teams are run individually by volunteer booster clubs who are solely responsible for the team's organization and coaches. A player must play at the school he/she attends.

PRACTICES

Only registered participants will be permitted to practice. Parents please contact your booster clubs for practice times and locations.

EQUIPMENT

Players are financially responsible for their equipment and jerseys. These items may sometimes be purchased through individual booster clubs. Cleated shoes are recommended. For more information about equipment, please see your individual booster club.

GAMES

Regular season games are scheduled to begin following the jamboree. Games will be played Monday through Thursday, and Saturdays. The season is expected to run through early November.

JAMBOREE

The football jamboree will be held in early September at Cherry Park. An admission fee of \$3 for adults and \$2 for children will be charged to ensure certification of all coaches through the National Youth Sports Coaching Association.
