Gardeners with the York County Master Gardeners Association are available on Fridays from 10am – 1pm to answer questions in person or by phone. Also during these times, soil samples may be dropped off for analysis. There is a \$6 lab fee for analysis which will provide ph and nutrient information. One pint of soil should be placed in a non-galvanized container. A plastic bag or container works well. Results are available within 7 – 10 days.
