## January Feature Outing: Linville Gorge Waterfall Hike

Jan. 28<sup>th</sup>, 2012

Cost: \$35 per person

Time: 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM

Discover one of the Carolina's natural wonders by accompanying Rock Hill Parks, Recreation, and Tourism, along with other hikers on a 2-mile moderate hike to socialize, exercise, and learn more about the history of the Linville Gorge Wilderness Area. Located 60 miles northeast of Asheville, and known as the "Grand Canyon of the East," this area is one of the wildest, most rugged gorges in the eastern United States. Linville Falls, with its spectacular views of waterfalls surrounded by numerous rock



formations and dense mixed forest, is an outdoor paradise for hikers. This trip is recommended for experienced hikers ages 12 and up. Trip meets at 8:00 a.m. at Rock Hill City Hall. Trip cost is \$35; experienced guide and transportation to and from the gorge are provided. Hikers should wear appropriate shoes and outerwear and bring water, snacks, and lunch.
